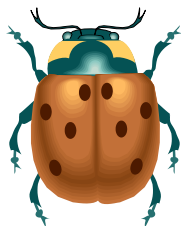

Application forms are available on the Civil Service Council's website for Civil Service Council sponsored scholarships for the 2010-2011 Academic year.

Civil Service Staff, with at least two years of continuous service and working toward a degree at Illinois State University, are eligible to apply for the Carl Johanson Scholarship, endowed by Al and Elaine Goldfarb.



Dependents of Civil Service staff working toward an undergraduate degree may also apply for scholarships. Up to six (6) \$1,000 dependent scholarships will be awarded through the Illinois State University Foundation. Recipients must be Illinois State University students. Additional scholarships may be awarded through Civil Service Council fundraising activities. These scholarships are typically \$500, and may be awarded to students attending any university or community college.

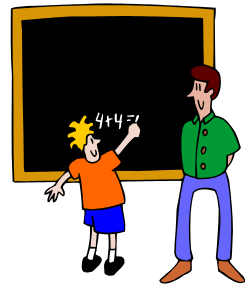
