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ANNUAL FOOD DRIVE REMINDER

The Annual Food Drive began March 1 and runs through March 31. Non-perishable food items will be collected and donated to the Bloomington Salvation Army Food Pantry. Families in financial hardship can receive a 3-4 day food supply from the food pantry. Last year the food pantry served over 3500 area families in need.

The Food Pantry will accept all non-perishable food items but they have given a list of special needs: canned meats, canned fruits, canned vegetables, boxed dinners such as Hamburger Helper, macaroni and cheese, Ramen noodles, peanut butter, rice—regular or quick cook, cereal—hot or cold, and jelly.

Red collection bins are located at Fell Hall, DeGarmo Hall, Moulton Hall, Stevenson Hall, Ropp Ag Building, Hovey Hall, Uptown Crossing, Alumni Center, and Office of Residential Life.

CIVIL SERVICE COUNCIL NOMINATIONS

“Now is the time for all good men (and women) to come to the aid of the Civil Service.” This paraphrase from typing class is exactly what the Civil Service Council needs. Elections for Council Representatives start with a call for nominations. Each of the five groups has three representatives, and one seat in each of the representative groups will be available this year. Council representatives are elected for three-year terms (terms follow the fiscal year - July 1 to June 30).



This year, our nomination and election processes will be completely on-line. Nominations will be open from March 19 to April 7, 2012, and you may nominate yourself or an individual within your own group to run in the election. Visit CSCouncil.IllinoisState.edu during the nomination period and click on the link for 2012 Elections. Once on the elections page you may click on the link for the nomination form specific to your group. In order to ensure that only members of your group can enter a nomination, the nomination process is password protected so you will be asked to enter your ulid and password. Also on the elections page will be a list of individuals for each group who are eligible to be nominated so group members are aware of eligible people in the same group.

Once nominations are closed and verified, voting will run from April 20 to May 12, 2012. During that time, Civil Service members will log into iCampus to cast a vote. Reminders for nominations and voting will be sent in campus mail, as well as printed in the April *OpenLine*.

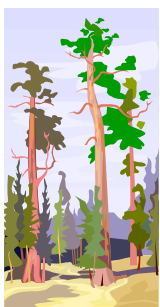

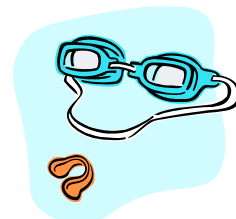

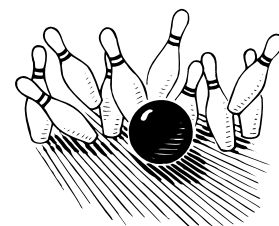

ISU DAY AT WRIGLEY FIELD

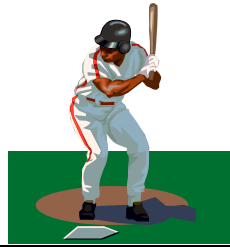

Trip policies:

- Trip cost is \$35 per person and includes: game ticket, bus transportation, bottled water and packaged snacks.
- You are welcome to bring your own snacks or alcohol-free beverages. No glass containers and no alcoholic beverages will be permitted on any bus. All items carried on buses are subject to inspection and must fit under your seat or in overhead bins. No items may be placed in the aisle.
- All seat reservations must include payment and are on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- Minors must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- In case of game cancellation, participants will be responsible for exchange or refund of their game tickets—refer to www.cubs.com for exchange policy.

Cancellation policy:

- Cancellations received by April 3 will get a full refund.
- Received between April 4 and April 17 will get \$17.50 refunded per ticket.
- Received on April 18 or after will get \$8.75 refunded per ticket.
- If we have a waiting list and can fill your seat, you will get a full refund.
- Refunds will be processed by the Civil Service Council treasurer and will not be given at the box office.
