## Treasurer's report

The operating account has $\$ 561.37$, and the scholarship account has $\$ 4,588.47$. The Carl Johansen Scholarship Foundation account has $\$ 4,000.00$ and Foundation account for scholarships to CS employee dependents has $\$ 20.00$.
